
Commitment to Agriculture Foundation / FFA Scholarship

The Commitment to Agriculture Foundation is excited to offer a scholarship program for Fremont and Weber High FFA members graduating from High School in 2011. The results of our Bar-J-Wrangler fundraiser and number of applicants will dictate the amount and number of scholarships awarded. Those awarded with scholarships will have up to two years to claim their funds unless they are granted an extension by the Utah CTA Board of Directors.

The eligibility requirements for this scholarship are as follows:

- US Citizen
- GPA Exceeding 2.0
- Weber or Fremont High FFA Member in Good Standing
- Graduating High School Senior in 2011

The Application Process:

- Create an application packet to include the following items:
 - Application completely filled out including signatures (available www.utahcta.org and chapter websites)
 - Two Letters of Recommendation (One may be from a teacher but one must be from a community member.)
 - Transcript from your High School.
- Mail the complete application packet to Melisa Griffith, Utah Commitment to Agriculture Foundation, PO Box 565, Huntsville, UT 84317. Must be postmarked by March 31, 2011.
- Attend an interview in April – date to be announced.

PLEASE NOTE: This scholarship is DIFFERENT from the CTA/4-H Scholarship. It is possible for youths who are active in both 4-H and FFA to apply for both scholarships; however, they will need to submit TWO SEPARATE scholarship packets and participate in two interviews. The criteria for the two scholarships are also different.
